Council met to finalize any outstanding issues for 2012. The motion to place \$105,000.00 into our Capital Reserve Fund was done. This figure was achieved because Council made decisions that were less than what was in the budget.

I attended my monthly meeting of Crime Stoppers in Campbellton. January is Crime Stoppers month and we are displaying the flag at our council chambers.

### January 10, 2013

I had a meeting with Roy Consultants to discuss the projects that are forecasted by Council in 2013. Council will have a presentation of these issues in February to supply direction.

### January 14, 2013

The monthly Committee of the Whole meeting was a very interesting session. Many issues were brought to the table and dates for our Strategic Plan update were set.

# January 15, 2013

I travelled to Moncton to attend a "Cost of Risk" seminar. This was designed to identify points of risk within a municipality and how to recognize them. I was very impressed with the information and looking forward to developing new ideas to help improve Belledune's planning tool box.

I am only trying to bring information to you and keep you informed on what is going on in your community.
