### **Message from Bathurst/Belledune RCMP – RSC3 – 2016-06-27**

The Bathurst/Belledune RCMP would like to advise the community of the following:

#### **Police Information Session – August 10, 2016**

Bathurst RCMP will be holding an information session on August 10, 2016 at 19:00 (7pm). The event will be held at the Belledune Rec. Centre on Main Street. The event will be to have general conversations with residents about various topics relating to policing. There is no set format thus everyone is welcome to come out and meet with police officers and ask whatever question you wish to ask. Come out and meet with us.

#### **Heat Warnings**

Make sure to always be aware of heat warnings when they are announced by local weather stations or on the radio. This can include both heat and humidex warnings. When dealing with extreme heat ensure to drink plenty of water, use sunscreen and wear a hat. Don't forget about your children and pets. We often think that leaving an animal only a couple of minutes in the car when it's hot is OK, however the temperature can get extremely hot in a matter of minutes thus always keep this in mind.

#### **Road Safety**

Local construction crews will be heading out on the roads of our area to fix some holes and paving roads. Always make sure to slow down in construction zones and obey the flag person giving directions. In New Brunswick the speeding fines are doubled in construction zones when workers are present therefore always make sure to be careful when crews are out.
