

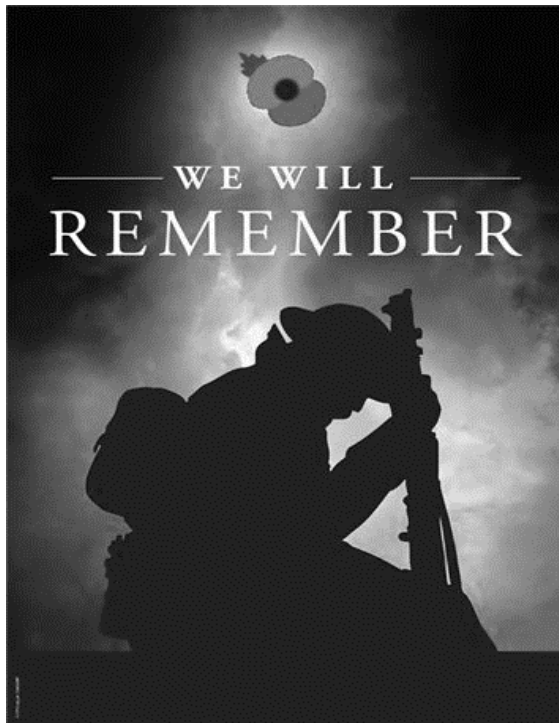

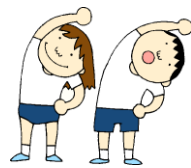

# CHRISTMAS IN THE VILLAGE

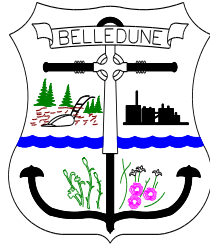


Belledune's 11<sup>th</sup> annual "Christmas in the Village" will be held at
