

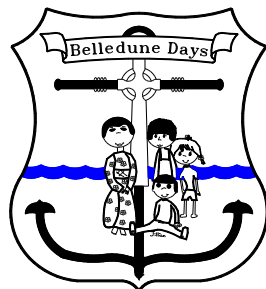

## **Belledune Solid Waste (Garbage) Collection**

### **LARGE ITEMS**

Large items, tv's, mattresses, sofas, etc. will be picked up on **Tuesday, August 29/17**. Please note - when putting out swing sets they should be taken apart, it is very difficult to put on the back of the truck when they are not taken apart.

### **BLUE RECYCLING BINS**

It has been brought to our attention that people have been using their recycling bins as garbage bins. Some people have also painted them black. The recycling bins are for **recycling only**. **We will no longer be picking up garbage that is being put in the recycling bins**. The recycling bins are the property of the Village of Belledune and were given to each household for the use of recycling only. If you move - the recycling bin is to stay with the house and not to be taken with you. If you have any questions or concerns please contact the Village Office.

## **Electro Braid Moose Fence Route #11**

Belledune Council wishes to advise the citizens that they are aware of the concerns over the condition of the Electro Braid Moose Fence on Route #11 and share their same safety concerns.

The fencing along this provincial highway is a provincial responsibility. In conjunction with Council, and after much discussion, the mayor has been corresponding with MLA, Daniel Guitard and DTI representative, Daniel LeBlanc to have this situation rectified.

The latest communications is that the province will do repairs to the electro braid fence this year (currently working on finding the funds) and the replacement of the electro braid fence with chain link fence is slated for 2019.

The Council at their meeting on June 26, 2017 passed a motion to submit a letter to the Minister of Transportation, Bill Fraser to have the repairs to electro braid fence completed this year as soon as possible and to have the fence replaced with chain link fence in 2018, rather than 2019.

### **Meeting Place**

This is in regards to the "Meeting Place" and Sunday school on Main Street, former Jacquet River, and East of the Station Lane. It's an attempt to keep the history of the area alive and in memory of the late Gordon Carmichael and friends who worked tirelessly to renovate the building and cemetery to its former glory i.e.: circa 1860.

The Meeting place or Sunday School consists of a one story wood building which once had a shingle roof, and was built in 1860 and was dedicated in 1868. It is located on the Turvey Estate and the lot for the building and cemetery was donated by Michael Turvey. It was called the "Meeting House" in the early days and served as a place of worship for Protestants of all denominations.

The cemetery which surrounds the building has interred therein the early village pioneers such as the first doctors, Ellis and Desbrisay, Mr Pride, (grist mill operator), Turvey (farmer), Fenderson (saw mill owner), MacAlister, Lutes (merchant), Brown (station agent) wives and families of the above and two persons who were killed in an accident at the Spool Mill in Becketville (no names or grave markers) to name a few. In all thirty four known persons are buried in the cemetery.

Since this is Canada's 150th birthday celebration, this building and cemetery are added to the Belledune Days Celebrations. The door will also be opened most Sundays for visits during the summer months. The visit will be a history lesson re the religious devotion of our village pioneers.

### Filling of Swimming Pools within the Village of Belledune

The Village of Belledune has implemented a new Policy regarding the filling of private residential swimming pools with water by the Belledune Volunteer Fire Department. Individuals requesting to have their swimming pool filled must fill in **RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM** (available from the Belledune municipal administrative office or on the Belledune website at [www.belledune.com](http://www.belledune.com)).

The completed Form must be submitted to the Belledune municipal administrative office, which will then be sent to the Chaleur Regional Services Commission – Planning Department, by municipal staff, for endorsement and confirmation that the planning regulations for the residential pool is compliant.

When dropping of the Form the individual must indicate the number of loads of water they are requesting (4,000 gallon per truck load) and pay the Village of Belledune the amount of \$100 per truck load, prior to delivery.

Once all conditions have been met and approved, the Belledune Volunteer Fire Dept. will be notified to proceed with the delivery of water. The delivery of the water will be at the earliest opportunity of the Belledune Volunteer Fire Dept.

The Bathurst/Belledune RCMP would like to advise the community of the following:

### **Road Safety – Construction Zones**

The RCMP would like to remind residents to practice safe driving in construction zones and follow posted speed limit signs. We have been receiving several complaints from construction crews of speeding in construction zones. If you see someone not obeying posted limits or not obeying construction flag persons please give us a call.

### **Heat Warnings**

Make sure to always be aware of heat warnings when they are announced by local weather stations or on the radio. This can include both heat and humidex warnings. When dealing with extreme heat ensure to drink plenty of water, use sunscreen and wear a hat. Don't forget about your children and pets. We often think that leaving an animal only a couple of minutes in the car when it's hot is OK, however the temperature can get extremely hot in a matter of minutes thus always keep this in mind.
