MUNICIPAL OFFICE

The Belledune Municipal office, located at 2471 Main St. is open to the public. When coming to the office, please adhere to all posted signage and physical distancing measures. Hand sanitizing station is available for visitors, and our common areas are disinfected after each visit. With these added precautionary measures in place, we are asking all residents to conduct as much business as possible over the phone, or by e-mail instead of in-person meetings. Walk-in appointments are not being allowed at this time, any meetings with staff are to be pre-scheduled. One person per appointment will be permitted. We are keeping a daily visitor record, so all visitors will be asked screening questions. Our offices will be closed between 12:00pm to 1:00pm, Monday to Friday, to allow for us to keep accurate information in the daily record. Garbage and Recycling Collection Notice

Please note a few items in regards to the Collection of Recycling and Garbage:

- We are asking people to put their Recycling bins out when it is ¾ full, when people wait until its full or overflowing it causes issues with the truck lift. Thank you for helping us out.
- The bins (or garbage bags) must be put out by 8:00am
- Garbage/Recycling bins or bags must be put at the end of the driveway on the shoulder of the road, some people are putting their bins half way up their driveways, if it is not at the end of the driveway we will not be picking it up.

There will be no large garbage collection until May 2021. Please do not put any large items or steel at
the roadside as it will not be picked up!!! If you do put anything out at the roadside you are
responsible to bring it back in because it will cause issues with the snow plow. We do not pick up tires
so please do not put them out.

Housing Subsidy Grant


Circle of Friends - Activity Center

SPECIAL NOTICES Spring Clean Up

Please note that <u>Spring Clean-Up for Residents only (not Commercial Establishments)</u> will be on <u>May 17, 19, 20 & 21/2021</u>. All regular garbage will be picked up on the regular scheduled days and other trucks will pick up special waste on the same days of your regular garbage pick-up. For example, if your regular garbage pick-up is on Monday, then the special pick-up for your area is on <u>Monday</u>.

(For Residential Customers Only – No commercial establishments) Conditions of Spring Clean Up

<u>Items to be picked up will be limited to</u>: wooden crates, furniture, large household appliances, bicycles, discarded metal or tools weighing under 50 pounds, branches no larger than 3 inches in diameter, and other household items not normally picked up during regular weekly collection.

<u>Items which will not be picked up:</u> discarded building and construction material, residue from trees such as stumps, trunks and branches (larger than three inches in diameter or if not bundled and tied), fencing, swimming pools, motorized vehicles, automotive parts over 50 pounds, stones, rocks, gravel, manure, carcasses of any dead animals, petroleum products, or hazardous waste (paint products).

- All Garbage & Waste must be at roadside by 8:00 A.M.
- All Steel Materials should be separate from other garbage
- Refrigerators must have Freon removed
- Branches must be bundled and tied (no longer than 4 feet in length and no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet square)
- Paint Products will be collected if solidified, no liquid paint products permitted.
- All loose garbage must be placed in bags or boxes (tied or taped) and weigh no more than 50 lbs.

SPECIAL NOTICES Notice #2 – Special Monthly Garbage Collection

A Special Garbage Collection will be done on the last Tuesday of each Month from <u>May until October</u> <u>2021, inclusive</u>. This Special Collection is for garbage other than your regular refuge. The same conditions as above apply. Pick up will start in lower Belledune at 8:00 A.M.
