The member must represent one of the following areas of expertise: festival, food and beverage, accommodation, tourist experience/activity, attractions, visitor information centre or regional organizations. The mandate of the Tourism Advisory Committee is to advise the Director of the Tourism Office in the development and promotion of the tourism industry in the Chaleur Region.
