- A copy of gym rules will be handed out.

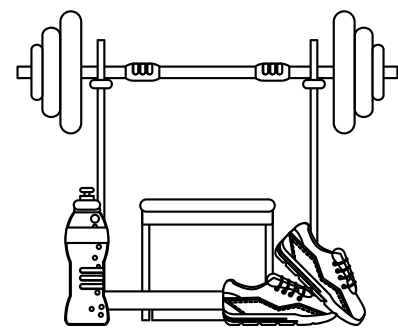
YOUTH POWER GYM PROGRAM (2/2)

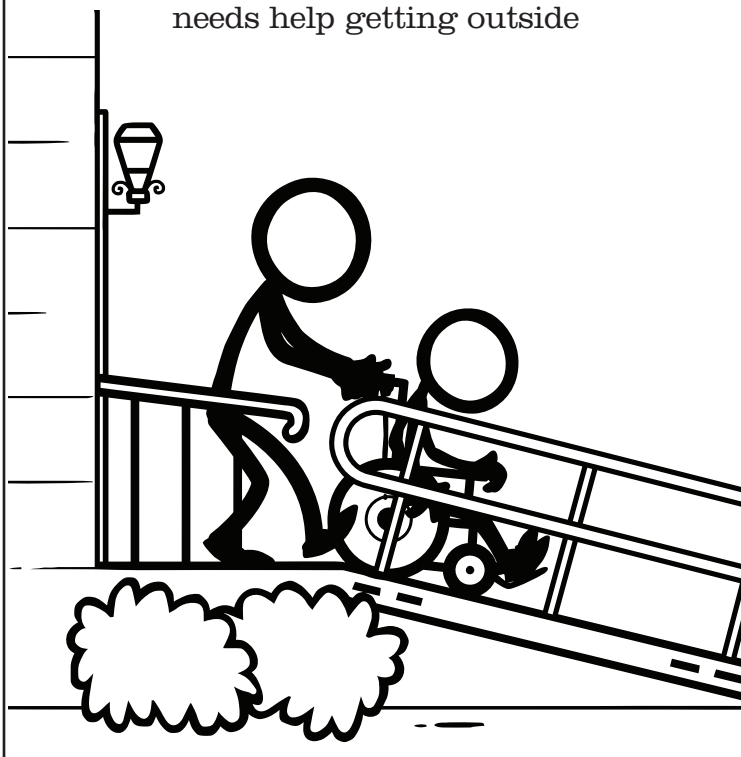
