4. If you are not able to drop off your returnables, contact one of the committee members and we will pick them up.

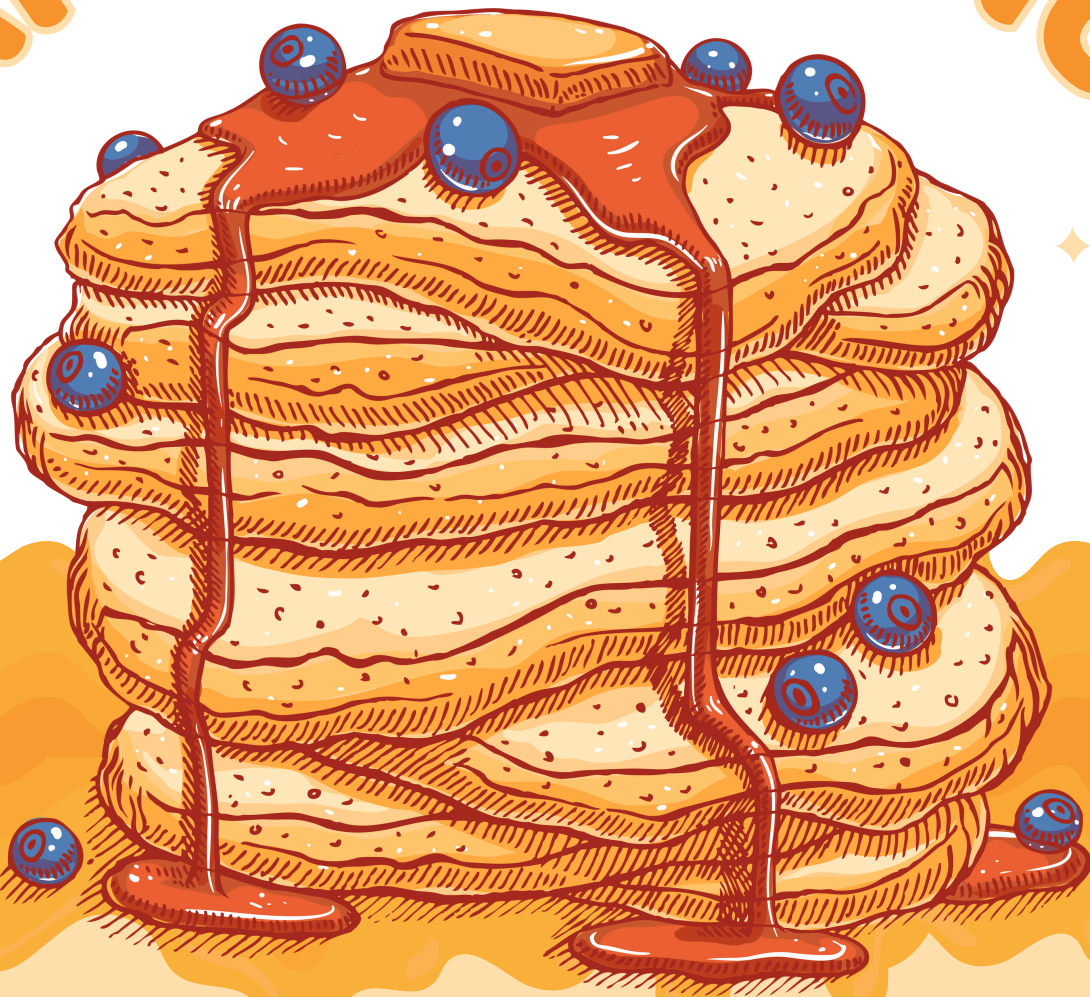

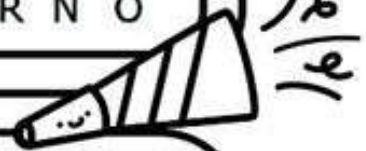
