

CONDITIONS OF SPECIAL GARBAGE PICKUP

Items to be picked up will be limited to:

- Wooden crates
- Furniture
- Large household appliances
- Bicycles
- Discarded metals weighing under 50 pounds
- Branches no larger than 3 inches in diameter
- Other household items not normally picked up during regular weekly collection

Items not to be picked up:

- Discarded building and construction material
- Residue from trees stumps, trunks, branches larger than 3 inches in diameter or if not bundled and tied
- Fencing
- Swimming Pools
- Motorized vehicles
- Automotive parts over 50 pounds
- Stones, rocks and gravel
- Manure
- Carcasses of any dead animals
- Petroleum products
- Household hazardous waste products
- All garbage & waste must be at roadside no later than 8:00 am
- All steel materials should be kept separate from other garbage
- Refrigerators must have freon removed
- Branches must be bundled and tied no longer than 4 feet in length and no larger than 2 feet x 2 feet square
- Paint products will be collected if solidified, no liquid paint products permitted
- All loose garbage must be placed in bags or boxes (tied or taped) and weigh no more than 50 pounds


