Approval of Curry Drive Project 049-23 to go to Tender

Presentation provided to Council by Guillaume Arseneau of Roy Consultants outlining details of the project. Mr. Arseneau noted for this project, Council had the ability to shut down Curry Drive, or have it remain partially opened. Closing the road would allow for a quicker construction time. CAO Lee noted Greenergy is now operating, so closing Curry Drive would prohibit truck traffic from accessing the

facility. There is a traffic by-law on Hodgins Rd. Councillor Bourque suggested that the trucking must go through the Port for the 4-week construction period.
