ADVERTISEMENT FOR OPERATING THE BELLEDUNE VETERANS MEMORIAL CENTRE ARENA CANTEEN

The Village of Belledune is seeking anyone interested in operating the canteen at the Veterans Memorial Centre Arena. The candidate will have to have a Food Service Preparation and Handling Certification and experience. This function will be responsible as an independent operator for purchasing all basic supplies for the creation of items prepared, space, equipment and power supplied by Village of Belledune. The person will also have to keep the canteen clean and in compliance with department of health regulations.

Hours of operation will be decided by the operator as he/she sees fit as long as it is during arena operating hours. The times must be posted in the Arena and the Municipal Office so that the public knows when it is open.

It will also be necessary to sign a contract with the Village. Terms and conditions will be discussed at the interview. The operator must comply with all work safe New Brunswick requirements as well as have at least 2 million dollars in liability insurance. They must also add the Village onto their own policy as being a third party indemnified, as per normal practice.

The free rental of the Water Wheel Chair will be available to any community member with mobility issues in order to have a safe and fun experience in pools and beaches. The rental, maintenance and cleaning of Water Wheel Chair will be done by Recreation and Wellness Department and will be stored at the Municipal Hall storage area (2471 Main Street).

Guidelines to follow:

- ✓ Water Wheel Chair must be reserved prior to rental via Recreation & Wellness at 506-520-9322 or 506-522-3714 (Darrell) or Email dculligan@belledune.com
- ✓ Renter will be given a short orientation on use and storage
- ✓ Renter is responsible for pick-up and drop-off of chair
- ✓ Renter must sign Rental and Liability form prior to rental and use
- ✓ One piece of ID must be presented at time of rental
- ✓ Renter must use equipment in a safe manner and never leave user alone while in the water or in chair
- ✓ Renter is responsible for safety of user and care of chair while in their possession
- ✓ Water Wheel Chair must be returned on date & time specified and in same condition after use

Cleaning/Disinfecting & Maintenance of Water Wheel Chair:

- ✓ Staff must wear disposable gloves at all times when cleaning, disinfecting and handling of chair
- ✓ All equipment to be Cleaned and Disinfected after each use
- ✓ After return the chair is inspected for any damages or issues
