GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION NOTICE

Please note a few items in regards to the Collection of Recycling and Garbage:

- The bins (or garbage bags) must be put out by 8:00
- Garbage/Recycling bins or bags must be put at the end of the driveway on the shoulder of the road, some people are putting their bins half way up their driveways, if it is not at the end of the driveway, we will not be picking it.

SPECIAL NOTICE – DITCHES AND CULVERTS

NEW RECYCLING SCHEDULE FOR 2022 - Very Important to Read

(New Schedule starting the week of July 5, 2022)

The Village of Belledune will be implementing a new schedule, starting July 5, for the collection of Recyclables. Instead of the Recycling being picked up once a month, **the Collection of Recyclables will still be on Tuesdays — however it will be picked up twice a month for each area.**

Recycling normally collected on Mondays and Wednesdays will be collected on the **1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month** (see schedule below)

Recycling normally collected on Thursdays and Fridays will be collected on the **2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month** (see schedule below)

GARBAGE will be collected on your regular days — no change for GARBAGE.

Guidelines for Water Wheel Chair Rental (FREE SERVICE)

The free rental of the Water Wheel Chair will be available to any community member with mobility issues in order to have a safe and fun experience in pools and beaches. The rental, maintenance and cleaning of Water Wheel Chair will be done by Recreation and Wellness Department and will be stored at the Municipal Hall storage area (2471 Main Street).

Guidelines to follow:

- ✓ Water Wheel Chair must be reserved prior to rental via Recreation & Wellness at 506-520-9322 or 506-522-3714 (Darrell) or Email dculligan@belledune.com
- ✓ Renter will be given a short orientation on use and storage
- ✓ Renter is responsible for pick-up and drop-off of chair
- ✓ Renter must sign Rental and Liability form prior to rental and use
- ✓ One piece of ID must be presented at time of rental
- ✓ Renter must use equipment in a safe manner and never leave user alone while in the water or in chair
- ✓ Renter is responsible for safety of user and care of chair while in their possession
- ✓ Water Wheel Chair must be returned on date & time specified and in same condition after use

Cleaning/Disinfecting & Maintenance of Water Wheel Chair:

- ✓ Staff must wear disposable gloves at all times when cleaning, disinfecting and handling of chair
- ✓ All equipment to be Cleaned and Disinfected after each use
- ✓ After return the chair is inspected for any damages or issues
