A collaboration between the Village of Belledune and Belledune Power Club will be offering a youth program of two 1-hour sessions per week.

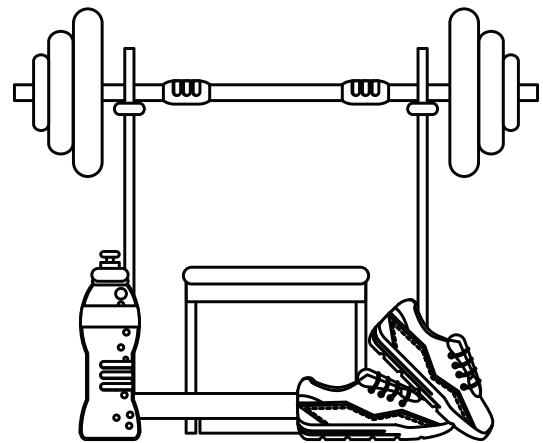
- Registration and orientation will take place on Mondays and Thursdays.

The Jacquet River Nature Group (JRNG) bird watchers meets on May 8 & June 12 at the Jacquet River school at 7 PM sharp. As well as bird sightings, we discuss all natural events that are of interest to attendees. Meetings are informal & informative.

We also have weekly outings to nearby birding sites led by top birders from the North Shore.

SPECIAL NOTICE – SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK FOR RESIDENTS ONLY

Spring clean-up for residents (does not include commercial establishments) will be on May 13, 15, 16 and 17, 2024. For this week, special pick-up will be on the same days of your regular garbage pick-up. If your regular garbage pick-up is on a Monday, then the special pick-up for your area is on a Monday. Please be aware this is a residential special garbage pick-up and does not include commercial establishments.

CONDITIONS OF SPRING CLEAN-UP

Items to be picked up will be limited to:

1. Wooden crates
2. Furniture
3. Large household appliances
4. Bicycles
5. Discarded Metal or tools (weighing under 50 pounds)
6. Branches no larger than 3 inches in diameter when bundled and tied.
7. Household items not normally picked up during regular weekly collection.

Items that will not be picked up:

1. Discarded building and construction material
2. Residue from trees such as stumps, trunks and branches larger than 3 inches in diameter or if not bundled and tied.
3. Fencing
4. Swimming pools
5. Motorized vehicles
6. Automotive parts over 50 pounds
7. Stones, rocks and gravel
8. Manure
9. Carcasses of any dead animals
10. Petroleum products
11. Hazardous waste

- All garbage and waste must be at roadside by 8:00 am.
- All steel materials should be separate from other garbage.
- Refrigerators must have freon removed.
- Branches must be bundled and tied, no longer than 4 feet in length and no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet square.
- Paint products will be collected if solidified, no liquid paint products permitted.
- All loose garbage must be placed in bags or boxes, tied or taped, and weigh no more than 50 pounds.

SPECIAL MONTHLY GARBAGE COLLECTION

The Special Monthly Garbage Collection will be done the last Tuesday of each month from May until October 2024. The same conditions as above apply.



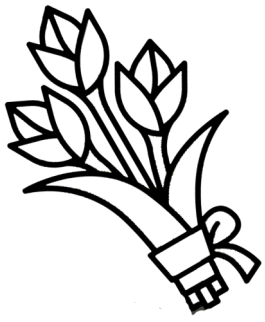
